



Project Update: June 2024

New Steveston Interchange Takes Shape

If you've driven along Highway 99 through Richmond in June, you will have seen the new Steveston Interchange coming to life.

This past month, crews erected large concrete beams—referred to as girders—across Highway 99. The girders form a platform on which the new traffic deck will be constructed. The project is currently in the first of a two-phase construction process.

During Phase 1, a new structure is being built on the north side of the existing overpass. Once complete, traffic will shift to the new structure and the existing overpass will be safely removed.

During Phase 2, a new structure will be built on the south side, creating the new, fivelane overpass. Throughout almost every step of construction we will keep traffic flowing as we work towards completion of the project in 2025.
