



Fraser River Tunnel Project

Highway 99 overnight lane closures

March to April 2025

As part of the Fraser River Tunnel Project to replace the George Massey Tunnel with a new eight-lane toll-free tunnel, there will be intermittent, overnight lane closures of Highway 99 between Westminster Highway and Highway 17 in March and April to allow crews to safely conduct geotechnical investigation work.

Crews will carry out the investigations near the new tunnel's portals and along the highway alignment in Richmond and Delta. The information gathered will help inform the final design of the project.

- To minimize traffic disruption, closures will take place from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Travel in both directions will be maintained at all times. Lane closures will only be implemented where the investigative work is underway.
- Lane closures will be well signed and traffic-control personnel will be on site to assist drivers when required.

Crews will collect soil samples via drilled boreholes along Highway 99 and within existing lanes and/or next to the highway. Heavy equipment, such as a hydraulic vacuum truck, a drilling rig and support vehicles will be used at each test-hole location.

What to Expect

Timing > Nightly during March and April 2025	Hours of Work > 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.
Traffic > Lane closures will occur on sections of Highway 99 adjacent to the area where the investigative work is being undertaken.	Impacts/Interruptions > Drivers may experience minor delays.
